The supplies listed have been determined as the necessary materials for each student to have in order to be prepared for school each day. This list includes the basic individual student supplies but teachers may request donations of additional classroom supplies to support their classroom needs. Classroom supplies will be utilized by all students. Any support from parents in providing these additional classroom supplies is greatly appreciated.

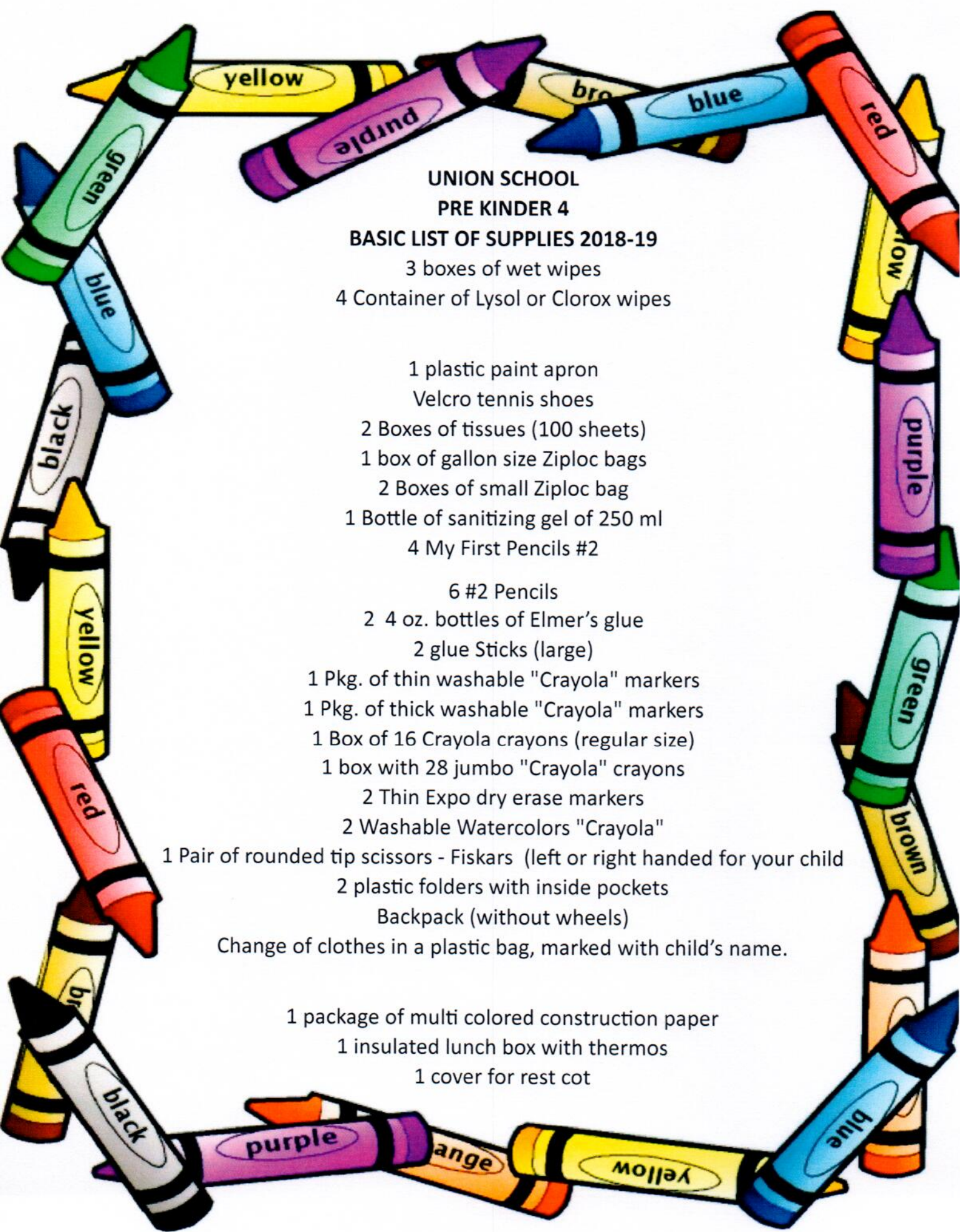
Each child will need a backpack (**No rolling backpacks, please!**) big enough to carry books, and work products. Please put your child's name on the backpack.

While certain brand names are recommended on this list, there is no requirement that the brand name be purchased. Different brand name items, similar in quality to the recommended brand names, may be substituted.

IN ADDITION...We ask that the children have a healthy snack for lunch. Neither candy nor carbonated drinks are allowed at the elementary level. All elementary students are asked to bring an extra snack to school. We schedule a short time in the afternoon so that they may have something to eat, as our regular lunch time is rather early in the day. **Microwaves** are not available for the elementary students. We urge all families to purchase **insulated lunch bags** to keep foods at desired temperatures.

We ask that students wear sneakers (black, white and shades of blue. **No trimmings of any other colors, please**) every day to school.

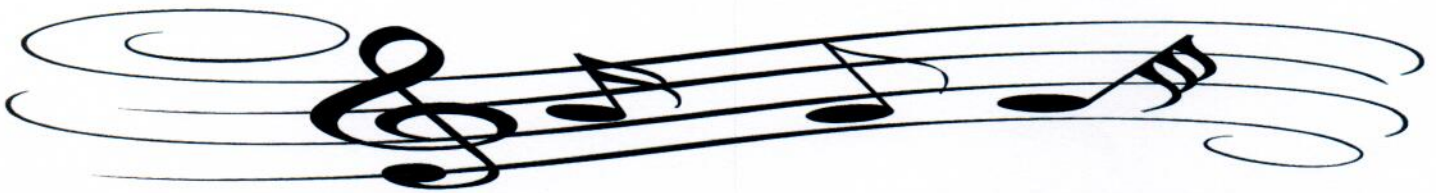
