

CHAGRIN

Strong feelings of embarrassment

CONSIGNING

Giving over to the care of another

CONSTRAINED

In a forced or inhibited manner

CONVERGED

Came together from different directions

DEBAUCH

Corrupt morally

DEFERENCE	Yielding to the opinion, wishes, or judgment of another
DEMURRED	Voiced opposition; objected
DESPATCH	Written, official message sent with speed
DIORAMA	Scene in which figures are arranged in a naturalistic setting against a painted background
DISPOSITION	One's usual mood; temperament

HOODWINK	Take in by deceptive means; deceive
HUSBANDRY	Practice of growing crops, & breeding and raising livestock
IMPETURBABLE	Unshakably calm and collected
IMPLICITLY	In a manner which is understood though not directly expressed
IMPOTENT	Lacking physical strength or vigor; weak

IRKSOME

Causing annoyance, weariness, or vexation

LAIR

Den or dwelling of a wild animal; a hideaway

LANGUID

Lacking energy or vitality; weak

MAELSTROM

Violent or turbulent situation; a large, violent whirlpool

MALADY

Disease, disorder, or ailment

RETICENT	Inclined to keep one's thoughts, feelings, and personal affairs to oneself
REVERENTLY	In a state of profound awe and respect and often love
SANGUINE	Cheerfully confident; optimistic; of a healthy reddish color
SATURNINE	Melancholy or sullen; tending to be bitter
SEXTON	Employee responsible for the upkeep of church property
