Required Tasks:

- Complete the two pages of personal response questions in the *Dracula* packet.
- Please choose 1 creative response task from the list of 14.
- Connections to the text questions.
- Film vs book comparison exercise (compare the re-adapted film "Dracula Untold" 1996 to the book).
